

**Carnegie Mellon

Teacher Training Courses**

Join Linda Ahlstedt, Shawn Funk and Patrick Ware for nine days: Friday, July 25-Saturday, August 2, 2008.

This schedule meets the required 60 hours by AOSA. Certification will be awarded at the end of the final session.

Cost: \$1500 for 3 CMU graduate credits or \$500 for certification. Act 48 credits are available.

Through this nine day course in the Orff Schulwerk approach to music and movement education, you will experience the development of conceptual lessons and process teaching, recorder playing, folk dance and movement training, and age appropriate sequential teaching technique. We shall also offer special topics of interest such as children's literature and music, curriculum planning, vocal health, assessment, inclusion and classroom management

Housing is available on campus in the New House. New House has private, air conditioned rooms with two beds. It also has an exercise room, laundry facilities, fully equipped kitchen, rec room and TV lounge. Cost: \$59.00 one person, \$29.50 each for two sharing a room

Basic Pedagogy: Linda Ahlstedt is a national workshop clinician, past president of AOSA, past interim editor of *The Orff Echo*, Level I, II and III teacher at Anna Maria College, Winthrop University and Carnegie Mellon, author of several books of Orff music for children and teaches music grades 3-5 in Penfield, NY. She is a recipient of the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra Musicians' Award for outstanding classroom music educator.

Recorder: Shawn Funk is elementary music specialist in the Fox Chapel Area School District in Pittsburgh, PA and adjunct professor at Duquesne University. He presents workshops throughout the U.S. and has published articles for the Orff Echo and PMEA and currently serves as editor of the elementary music column for the PMEA news. He performs as a piano accompanist and chamber musician with his wife Anne, a violinist.

Movement: Patrick Ware is an active musician and choral conductor at the local, state and national levels. Patrick teaches K-3 movement, 4-6 general music and chorus in Fairfax County, Virginia. He teaches movement and recorder at Anna Maria College in Worcester, MA and movement at Carnegie Mellon. Special focuses in his courses include the use of literature and arts integration in the curriculum.
